 - a. Road Commission (driveway permit for change of use).
 - b. Health Department (well and septic).
 - c. Fire Department.

All voted in favor. Motion carried.

7. Parks and Recreation Plan

David Jirousek reviewed with commissioners the 2023 Parks and Recreation Plan and Trail Project timeline. There were some changes/corrections noted by commissioners that will be corrected by David. There will be a formal draft presented to the Planning Commission on November 30th.

8. Environmental Regulations and Wellhead Protection Overlay District

Paquin reviewed progress being made in this area, initial draft and performance standards were handed out to commissioners at the October meeting, those not in attendance at that meeting will be given the information for their review.
